System reports categories

System reports are grouped in four main categories:

- Performance monitor;
- Administration & security;
- Process usage & performance;
- System log.

Each category contains different set of dedicated reports.

Performance monitor reports

Here is the list of the [performance monitor](#) ↗ reports.

Report name	Description
Performance monitor aggregated	Report shows total summerized execution time (<i>in seconds</i>) of each operation that have been performed on each server during the last 30 days.
Performance Monitor Dictionaries Synchronization	Here you find information about how much time (<i>in seconds</i>) it takes to synchronize each external dictionary on each server in the last 24 hours.
Performance monitor Job Execution	In this report you find information about how much time (<i>in seconds</i>) it takes for each system job to perform on each server in the last 24 hours.
Performance monitor Rules Execution	Report shows total summerized execution time (<i>in seconds</i>) of each process rule on each server in the last 24 hours.

Administration & security reports

Here is the list of the administration and security reports.

Report name	Description
Report list	Here you find a list of all reports defined in the system.
Reports by category	Report shows how many reports have been created in each category and subcategory so far.
Reports by creator	Report shows how many reports each user has created so far.

Process usage & performance reports

Here is the list of the process usage and performance reports.

Report name	Description
Average case duration	Here you can see if average processing time lowers (cases are processed more quickly) or otherwise.
Cases created yearly	You can see how many cases are created each year. This shows how much AMODIT is used in organization.

System log reports

Here is the list of the system log reports.

Report name	Description
System logs by message	Report shows number of records registered in the system log per each AMODIT functional module and message (<i>mainly error message</i>) in every month of the year.
System logs by module	Report shows number of records registered in the system log per each AMODIT functional module in every month of the year.
System logs by server	Report shows how many items are added to system log on each server. Higher numbers usually mean there were more operations or there were more exceptions or problems.
System logs by status	Report shows number of records registered in the system log grouped by their status (1 - error, 2 - information, 3 - verbose logging) in every month of the year.
